Paul Hemmer Companies has announced plans to develop and construct a 36,000-square-foot medical office building next to the Jewish Hospital medical office building on Mason Montgomery Road near the Deerfield Towne Center.

Alliance Primary Care has signed a lease for 19,000 square feet and will occupy the second floor of the center.

A groundbreaking ceremony will be held at 11 a.m. Wednesday. Construction will begin immediately. The \$6 million project is expected to be completed by mid summer 2008, according to a Hemmer statement.
